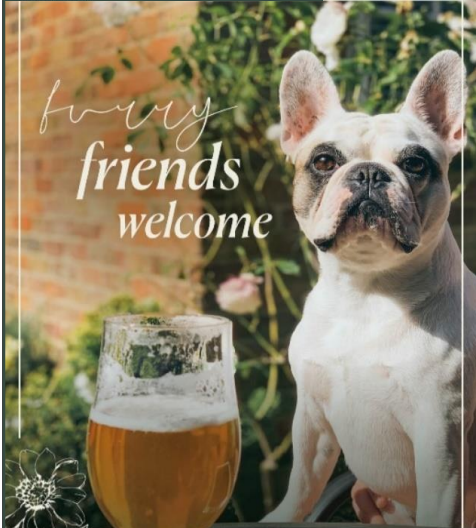

Chair's Welcome

Welcome to Goostrey Rose Day 2023. It will be a very special day for this year's Rose Queen, Ella Wilford, and for our Rosebud Queen, Phoebe Sharman. But it's a day of celebration for everyone in our village.

The many wonderful photos in Goostrey Parish Archive and on the Rose Festival website show that we are continuing a tradition that began over 100 years ago. In recognition of the history of Goostrey Rose Day, the committee has invited the Rose Queens who were crowned in 1998, 1973 and 1963 to take part in the procession and the crowning ceremony. Vicky Crouch is our silver Rose Queen, Beverley Elton is our gold Rose Queen and Hazel Challinor is our diamond Rose Queen.

We are delighted that Hazel will also be our President this year. She took part in her first Rose Day in 1952 and has attended almost every one since then. As an active member of the WI, she regularly works on their stall.

Sincere thanks must go to all members of the Rose Festival committee. Without the dedication and enthusiasm of this small group of people, none of the events that we enjoy on Rose Day would be happening. In March, we organised the selection of the Rose Queen, the Rosebud Queen and the attendants for 2023. The same afternoon, there was a party for infant children with a pop-up cafe for their parents. To raise funds to support the visit of children and teachers from Elizabethfontein in South Africa, we worked with staff at Goostrey Community Primary School to run an auction of promises and a quiz. Since then, we have all concentrated on organising Rose Day itself.

I'm grateful that there are scores of other people in our local community who support Goostrey Rose Festival in numerous ways. If anyone would like to join the committee, there's a wide range of jobs to do - from organising the procession, the activities on the field and refreshments in the village hall, to selling wrist bands and finding prizes for the draw and the tombola. In addition, other committee members gather material for the programme, oversee the competitions, record the minutes of our meetings and monitor the finances. New volunteers will be warmly welcomed.

I hope you enjoy reading this programme, don't forget that the latest information about Rose Day can be found on our website and on Facebook.

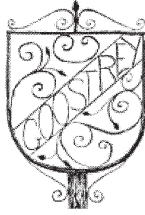

GOOSTREY PLAYING FIELDS

Why not enjoy playing Bowls, Tennis and Football at the Goostrey Playing Fields on Boothbed Lane, Goostrey (CW4 8PR)? The facilities are owned and run by the Goostrey VHPFF (a Charitable Trust) for the benefit of the local community.

The current **annual** subscriptions, which run for a full calendar year (i.e. January to December) are:

- £30 per household or
- £10 each for Over 60s.

All households in Goostrey and its adjacent Parishes (Twemlow, Cranage, Allostock, Over Peover, Swettenham and Lower Withington) are eligible to become Registered Users of the astroturf, football field and bowling green. You can use the facilities on a "casual" basis, or book a slot, or join one of the Affiliated Clubs. We ask that people use the facilities responsibly and wear the correct footwear.

Affiliated Clubs (currently Tennis, Bowls and Friendly Football Club) have priority times to use the facilities and if you wish to join any of these Clubs as well, then an additional fee will be payable direct to the Club concerned.

Also, for £5/month, anyone can join the Goostrey Turf Account (Lottery) with quarterly draws and a Grand Christmas Prize of £1,000. Your chances of winning are currently greater than 1 in 100!

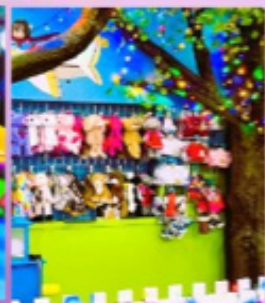

Honouring Margaret Kettle

Margaret Kettle, probably Goostrey Rose Festival's biggest fan, sadly died in December, aged 100. Margaret lived in and around Goostrey all her life and she and her late husband George ran the village post office for many years.

In addition to being crowned Rose Queen in 1936, Margaret was the Festival President on two occasions. In an article for the Centenary programme, she wrote about being President in 1986: "It was a wonderful day. I then decided I wanted to be part of Rose Day for as long as I was able and to collect as much as I could to help funds. As not many people were dressing up and going round with a tin, I decided to go in fancy dress."

Margaret attended Rose Day as various characters over the years including Minnie Mouse, Bertie Bassett, Yogi Bear, Carmen Miranda, Wonder Woman, Barbara Cartland, Dame Edna Everage and Charlie Chaplin. Each year people would eagerly await to see who Margaret was dressed up as, so it is only fitting that a new Margaret Kettle trophy in her memory will be presented at this year's Rose Day.

The trophy will be awarded to the best dressed adult who walks in the procession from Booth Bed Lane to the school field or someone on one of the adult floats. The competition will be judged as the procession passes the Crown by Margaret's granddaughter Leyla Woodward who has also provided the new trophy. At one time a lot of people would make a special effort to dress up for Rose Day and we hope that this year the tradition will be revived in memory of Margaret, a very special person who will be sadly missed.

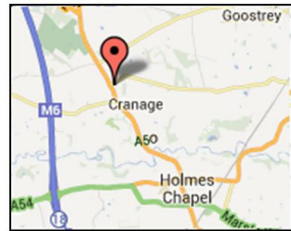

Welcoming visitors from Elizabethfontein School

This year Goostrey Rose Festival will be welcoming eight children and two teachers from the Elizabethfontein School in the Western Cape, South Africa. This is the sixth time since 2005 that pupils from Elizabethfontein, which is twinned with Goostrey Community Primary School, have taken part in our Rose Day celebrations.

The children, who are staying with families in the village, will also be taking part in lessons at Goostrey school and demonstrating crafts, sharing South African playground games and dancing. The school has won numerous dancing competitions throughout the Western Cape and the children will be performing during the afternoon.

The rural Elizabethfontein School, which is a three-and-a-half-hour drive North of Cape Town, has 270 children most of whom board on a weekly basis in two huge dormitories.

The children should have visited us in 2020 but the pandemic meant that their trip had to be cancelled but we are delighted that they are with us again this year.

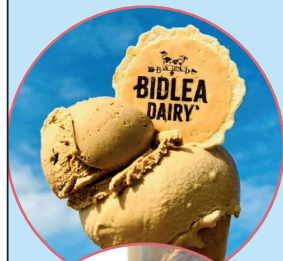

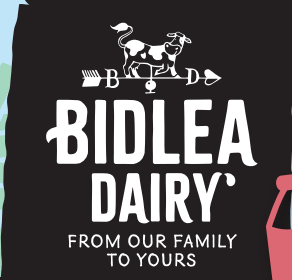

Important Information

Wristbands

Wristbands, which cost £2.50 for adults and £1 for concessions, children are free, will be available again this year. The wristbands, which allow entry to the field from 2pm, can be purchased from the Trading Post in the week running up to Rose Day and they will be on sale at the school field from 9am on the morning of the day, before the floats set off from Booth Bed Lane and outside The Crown before they arrive.

Road Closure

Main Road will be closed between Booth Bed Lane and Church Bank from 1- 2 pm on Rose Day and access to Booth Bed Lane from Main Road will not be permitted from 12 noon until the procession has left.

Procession

Please ensure that all children taking part in the procession arrive at the starting point on Booth Bed Lane at 12.30pm so that the procession can leave promptly at 1pm. For safety reasons and in order to ensure that all onlookers can see, only marshals are permitted to walk alongside the floats. Cycling is strictly forbidden.

Prayers at the War Memorial

The Rose Queen and her entourage will process to the church for the traditional prayers and wreath laying with the Rev Canon Christine Broad.

Car Parking

Please use the field opposite The Crown (accessed before the procession by the roundabout at the bottom of the school drive) or the special facility at the back of The Space Invader. Only cars with special permits and disabled drivers will be allowed on the Village Hall car park.

Cash

Rose Day remains essentially a cash event although there will be limited opportunities to pay by QR code on a mobile phone. We are unable to accept card payments.

Tickets for the Ceilidh will be available from Peter Gomes on 07867 798848. Adults £10, children £5. This year we will not be serving food so bring your own picnic, drink and (plastic) glasses.
